Interior Design is a multi-faceted discipline that focuses on conceptulizing and designing of interior spaces in such a way that they are conducive to high-quality and high productive life. The profession also considers safety and welfare protocol norms laid out by the regulating bodies. The career demands for an artistic bent of mind and good imagination for space planning, construction management and effective use of available materials and products. The job of an interior designer in an ever evolving and changing world is to create spaces which are plush, functional and adaptable in an residential or a workplace to motivate and encourage the user.

The School of Planning and Architecture offers a full-time four year course that enables the student to visualize, sketch, research, design and detail interior spaces of different typologies such as residential, commercial, recreational, hospitality, healthcare, cultural and recreational spaces. It is an interdisciplinary course which encompasses furniture design, product design, human psychology, environmental control, etc., The course equips the student to design a 'biophilic' environment with importance to indoor environmental control.

The course instills a strong foundation of interdisciplinary skills with an emphasis on the latest materials available, construction techniques, accessory design and a vareity of workshops like photography, textile design, furniture manufacturing, metal works, etc,.

COURSE STRUCTURE
